2. Click on **Find a Program**
3. Type in the program you are interested in, in the "Find a Program" space.
4. Click on a program title for each school. This will provide a link to the university website or the program website. The program website will give you specific program information.

### Searching for a Specific University

2. Click on **Choose an Ontario University**
3. Click on a university you would like to investigate.

- grade requirements
- details about admission offers
- details about alternate offers
- what courses you would take in first year
- residence information and scholarships
- print off your results or use the **Program Details Form** to keep track of information

### Researching Professional Schools (For those programs that require some undergraduate study: Dentistry, Medicine, Law, Consecutive Education, some Nursing programs, Rehab Sciences, Nurse Practitioner, Pharmacy, Physician Assistant, Optometry, Veterinary Medicine)

1. Go to [electronicinfo.ca](http://electronicinfo.ca)
2. Click on **Find a Program**
3. In the right hand tool bar click on **Programs Requiring Prior University Study**
4. Click on the professional application you are interested in **or** type in the program name in the search bar. This will give you a list of the programs/schools you are interested
