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Mature Prior Learning Assessment Recognition

- Are you 18 years old or older?
- Have you been out of school for a year?

You may be eligible to earn credits for your life experience and put them towards your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). It is an official evaluation and credit granting process that allows some adults to earn credits for knowledge and skills acquired outside of a secondary school.

Co-operative Education Courses

Co-operative education is a partnership between high schools and communities that provides individuals with meaningful career skills. You may earn high school credits while you work and expand your current workplace skills. Possibilities allow you to earn credits within your current place of employment.

Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP)

The Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program is a school to work program that allows students to explore work in apprenticeship occupations in a co-operative education setting. Students have the opportunity to become registered apprentices and work towards becoming certified. Unique courses for the CDSBEO OYAP Program include partnerships with the Meat Cutting School in Cornwall and Hairstyling with Elegance College in Cornwall.



Dual Credit Programs

Dual Credit Courses allow students to learn on a college campus and earn both a secondary and college credit. Transportation, materials, and teacher support are included with this program at no charge to you.

Personal Support Worker (PSW)

This program is for individuals wishing to enter the health care field through an accredited PSW program. Placement opportunities include working in a community setting or long-term care facility. The course is 5 months in length and you may earn 7 high school credits through the program to put towards your OSSD.
