# Your Ontario University Application

## TIMELINES:

**Mid November:** Pick up your online university application login information in the guidance office.

**Friday December 22, 2017:** Holy Trinity Deadline for submitting your university application online to the OUAC at [www.ouac.on.ca](http://www.ouac.on.ca).

**January 17, 2018:** OUAC Deadline for secondary school students to submit completed on-line applications to the OUAC

**February 5, 2018:** Recommended last date for students to submit all information to the OUAC, including university and program changes, as well as additional active choices, to be eligible for consideration for early admission. Please note that this is not a deadline date. Changes will be accepted and processed by the OUAC at any time.

**May 25, 2018:** The latest date by which all secondary school applicants shall expect a response of

1. an offer of admission,
2. a refusal, or
3. a deferral pending the receipt of specific additional information

**June 1, 2018:** The earliest date by which Ontario universities may require a response to an offer of admission.

## Application Fees

-An application fee of **\$150** allows students **three** choices.

- Applicants who wish to select additional university programs can do so at a cost of **\$50** for each additional selection

-Payment can be made by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express) or online banking. Prepaid credit cards and VISA debit cards are not accepted.

## Quebec and out of Province Universities

☞ Most applications to out of province universities are due by **March 1, 2018** (McGill, **February 1, 2018**). Make sure you check the deadline of the institution you plan on attending.

☞ While there is no quota on the number of out of province applications a student can make, each university requires a separate application fee.

☞ If applying to an out of province university, it is **your responsibility** to make sure your marks are sent at the 1) end of first semester, 2) mid-term second semester, and 3) end of second semester.



## A University Bound Student's Checklist

- Investigate universities:
  - ☺ Research the academic calendars.
  - ☺ Compare institutions: Maclean's; [www.electronicinfo.ca](http://www.electronicinfo.ca); [www.ouac.on.ca](http://www.ouac.on.ca);
  - ☺ Listen to talks by "liaison" officers.
  - ☺ Talk to recent graduates.
  - ☺ Talk to a Guidance Counsellor.
  - ☺ Talk to faculty members.
  - ☺ Talk to your parents.
  - ☺ Visit the universities' web sites
  - ☺ Visit the campus / Open House
  
- Sign up in the guidance office for the appropriate university liaison officers' visits
  
- Make an appointment to see your guidance counselor.
  
- Complete and hand in a Graduate Profile **Deadline: November 10, 2017.**
  
- Pay \$30 for your graduation gown rental **Deadline: November 10, 2017.**  
*Please note: late payment fee after November 10<sup>th</sup> will be \$40...after January 23<sup>rd</sup> \$50*
  
- Apply online to Ontario Universities **Deadline: December 22, 2017.**  
[www.ouac.on.ca](http://www.ouac.on.ca)
  
- Show proof of completion of Community Service Hours **Deadline: Monday May 22, 2018**
  
- Apply to out of province universities. (Check individual universities for deadlines)
  
- If applying to out of province schools, **make sure** your 1<sup>st</sup> semester marks, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester mid-term marks and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester final marks are sent to the appropriate out of province universities
  
- Visit university campuses (March break is a good time for many students)
  
- Late May: apply for OSAP
  
- Once you have accepted an offer of admission, inform your guidance counsellor of the decision.
