Name of Course/Course Code: Grade 10, French Immersion (FIF2D)

Course Prerequisite: FIF1D

Course Description: This course enables students to increase their knowledge of the French language and further develop their language skills through the study of twentieth-century European francophone literature and culture. Students will participate in oral communication, reading, and writing activities based on a variety of French literacy and media works. They will study at least one novel and a selection of short stories, plays, and articles.

Catholic Graduate Expectations: Students will be expected to listen, speak, read, write sensitively, and respond in French in light of Gospel values. They will be expected to be responsible citizens who respect the Catholic teachings of peace, justice, and the sacredness of human life.
