

## University Bound Graduates

In order to apply to an Ontario university, you must apply through the OUAC (Ontario University Application Centre). The cost is \$150 (2017 Price) and this allows you to apply to 3 programs (\$50 for each additional program). To apply to a university outside Ontario, you must apply to each university individually (i.e. go to their website and apply online).

**\*\*\*Please book an appointment with a guidance counsellor before December 1<sup>st</sup> to ensure you are on track to GRADUATE!! You can also pick up your PIN # and apply to university. You will need a credit card. \*\*\***

- **The latest date by which all secondary school applicants shall expect a response from an Ontario university (Offer of Admission, a Refusal or a Deferral pending the receipt of additional information).**

#### **June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019**

- **The earliest date by which an Ontario University may require a response to an offer of admission and a financial commitment of any kind.**

#### **June 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

- **Graduation Day** 🎓

***Grad gown payment of \$25 and community hours (Minimum of 40 hours) must be submitted before prom (Mid May). If not submitted, graduates will not be permitted to purchase tickets to attend prom.***
