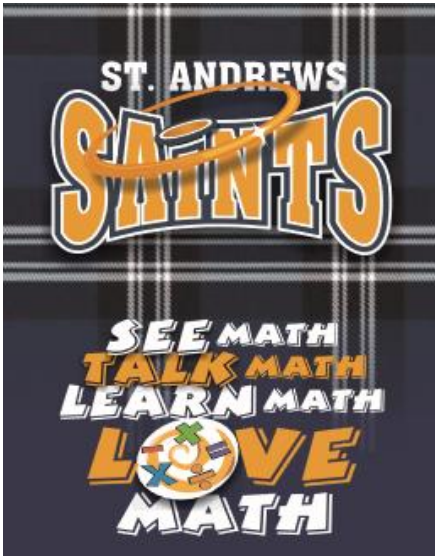


# A YEAR IN REVIEW ...
