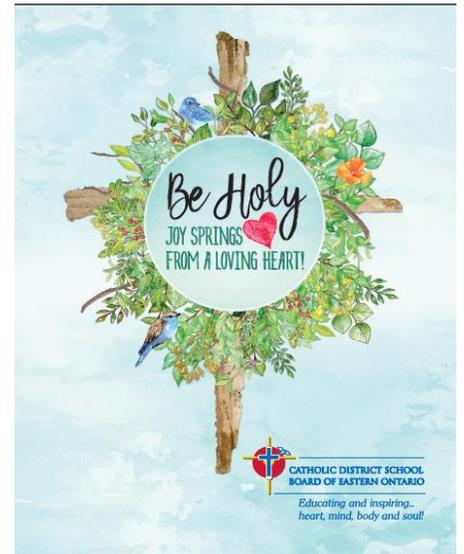
Please continue your commitment to your child's education during July and August. Keeping your child reading throughout the summer will improve their literacy skills.

This month we are focusing on the virtue of fairness. Fairness is treating everyone with kindness and respect.



Be a Math Role Model

You are an important part to your child's success in math. It is true! Your encouragement, interest, and positive attitudes about math can go a long way to helping your child.

The following are samples of questions that support the development of these math processes.

Problem Solving

What is happening in this problem?

What am I asked to find?

What do I know that I can use to solve this?

Reasoning and Proving

Why does this make sense?

How do I know my solution is right?

Reflecting

How else could I have solved this problem?

What did I learn from doing this work?

Keeping Children Safe in Pools and Around Waterfronts

With the arrival of warmer weather, children everywhere are looking forward to having fun and cooling down in pools, lakes and other bodies of water. However, it is important that they have fun safely as drowning is the second leading cause of injury-related death for children in Canada.

Here are some tips to keep children safe in and around bodies of water:

- Whether a lifeguard services a pool or beach or not, children less than 10 years old should be accompanied by a guardian who is at least 12 years old.
- Stay within sight and arm's reach of any child under 5 years old or who does not swim well.
- Make sure young children and weak swimmers wear life jackets.
- Enroll your children in swimming lessons as soon as possible. Nevertheless, remember that teaching children to swim does not mean that they are safe in the water.
- No one should swim in an abandoned open pit mine or quarry where water has accumulated.
