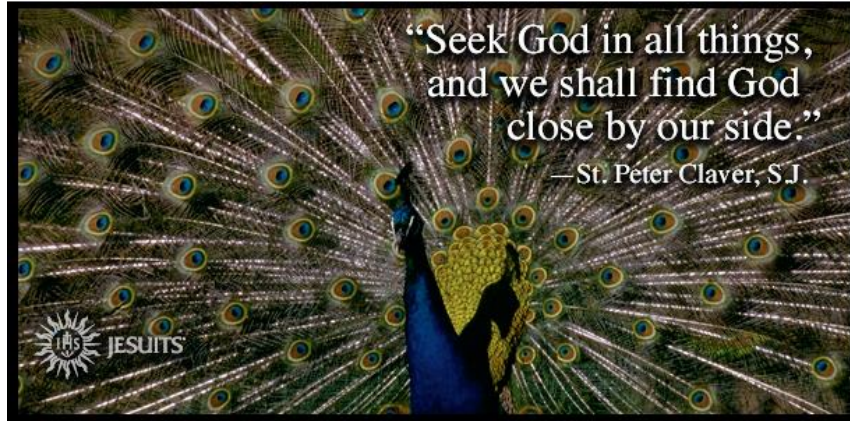

Next week is Kindness Carnival Week and there are a several things planned.

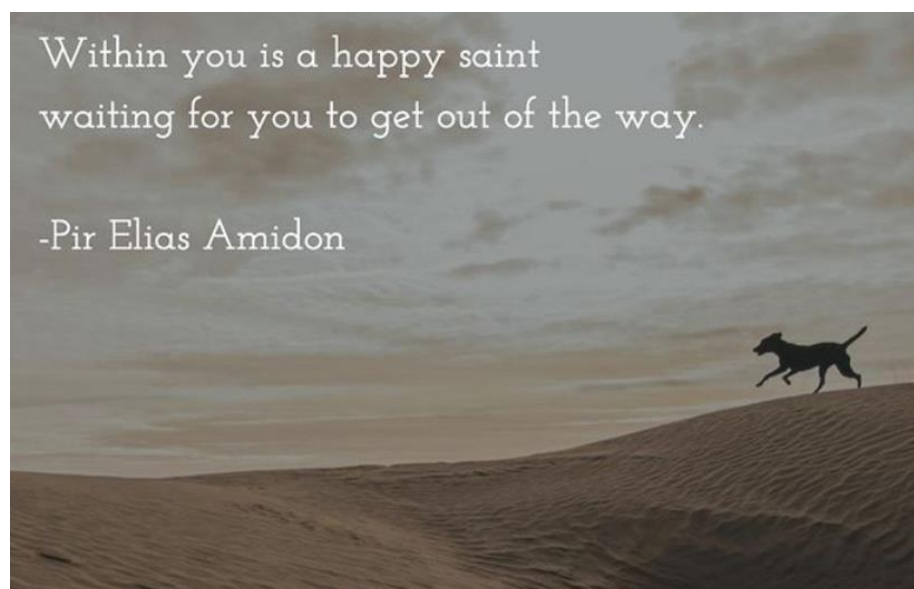
- We will have grade 5/6 reading announcements each morning, ending with a challenge of the day.

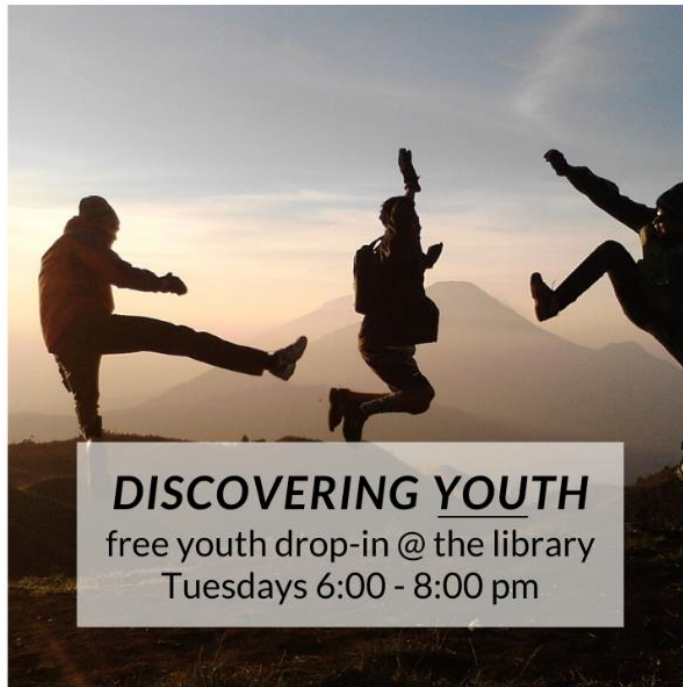
