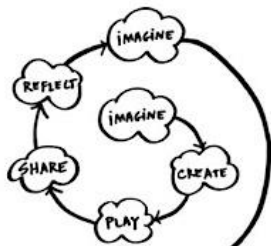
Jolly Phonics: Letter D again because of the snow days last week and the letter G. G is for God, games, and Mrs. Garvin!
