Please talk to your child about keeping their hats and mitts in their cubbies (with their lunch pails) or in their backpacks - not on top of their cubbies where they might come into contact with other hats and mitts.

<u>Please note:</u> Unfortunately, we have had a reported case of <u>pinworms</u> in our classroom. Please talk to your child about the importance of washing their hands with soap and water ~ especially after they use the bathroom and keeping their hands away from their eyes, nose and mouth.
