This Week in Kindergarten...

Please note...

This is **Fire Prevention and Safety Week**. The children will participate in a variety of lessons and activities; we will brainstorm things that belong in a fire-station and then turn our dramatic play area into one. It will really help if you could review Fire-Drill procedures with your child: *we leave the building through the closest door (in our classroom, we use the door that exits onto the recess yard), if we are in another school location, we leave through the closest exit and meet on the big yard at the fence, we are empty handed and we remain quiet so that we can hear all instructions. We do not cover our ears as we need to hear all instructions.*

Jolly Phonics: "Ii"... Inky the Mouse has crept into the house and his tail has tipped over the ink. He scratches his whiskers and says, "i-i-i-i" - short 'i' sound as in ink, in, igloo. What was in the Mystery Box today???? (instruments). Do you have an "Ii" in your name? Many thanks to families who have sent in words that begin with our letter of the week; if you have not done so yet, please do!

Classroom and Library Books are now due on Thursdays please. This gives us time to organize the books and prepare the next ones to go home. This week your child will choose a non-fiction book/magazine. Sometimes there may be a lot of text/writing in the books. If this is the case, you may wish to read a little and discuss the pictures.
