

On January 27, 2018, Family Literacy Day will celebrate 19 years of learning as a family. The initiative, created by ABC Life Literacy Canada in 1999, has been embraced by literacy organizations, schools and libraries all across Canada. ABC Life Literacy Canada is encouraging Canadian families to have "15 Minutes of Fun" learning together.




Family literacy refers to the many ways families develop and use literacy skills, from enjoying a storybook together at bedtime and during the day, to playing with word games, singing, writing to a relative or friend, sharing day-to-day tasks such as making a shopping list or using a recipe, and surfing the Internet for fun and interesting sites (Family Literacy in Canada: Profiles of Effective Practices, Adele Thomas, Soleil Publishing Inc., 1998). These teachable moments at home help children learn listening skills and language skills, and develop their imaginations and creativity — and are also opportunities for adults to practise their skills.

**Inferring/Inférence** is the reading strategy that will be taught and focused on in the months of January and February across all grades in both the English and French Language Arts Programs.


Our next meeting will be held on February 13th at 6:30 pm in the school library. Parents and guardians are always welcome and encouraged to attend! We look forward to seeing you.
