SUPPLIES FRENCH/ENGLISH**

The following is a basic list of supplies that your child will require in Kindergarten. Please make sure that **each item is labeled with your child's name.**

- ✓ School bag-labeled (big enough for library books, agenda and a lunch box).
- ✓ Change of clothes: underwear, pants, shirt and socks in a **LABELED** ZIPOC BAG, thank you.
- ✓ Pair of Velcro indoor running shoes (non-marking soles) to be kept at school-labeled.
- ✓ Labeled lunch box and their contents.
- ✓ Please label your child's personal belongings. Example: coats, hats, etc.
- ✓ No nut products.

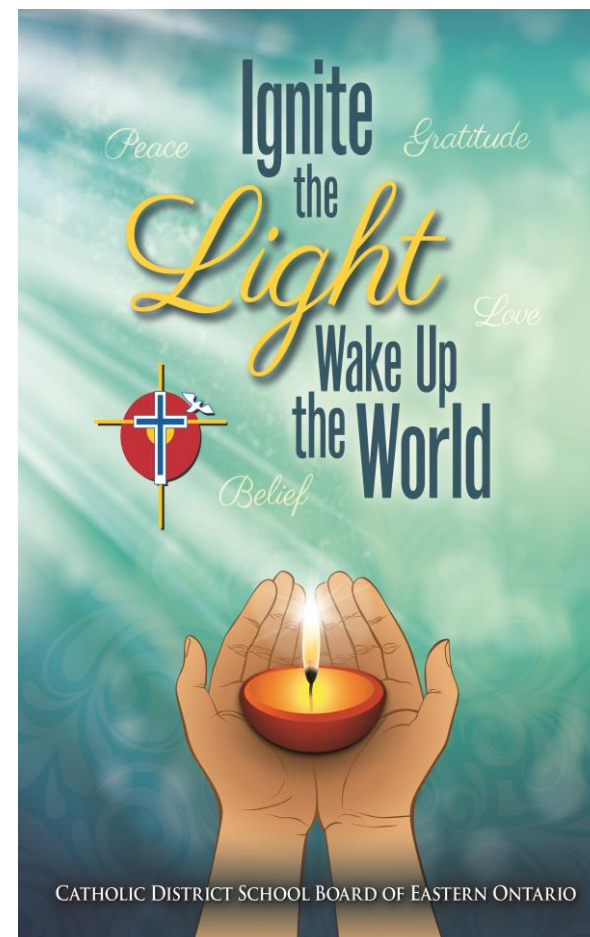
Healthy lunch with morning and afternoon snacks including fruit, raw vegetables and dairy products.

Safe School Arrival Policy

Attendance is recorded twice daily. If your child is going to be absent or late, please contact the school **(613-678-5455)**. To ensure each student's safety, the school secretary will telephone parents to verify unmotivated absences.

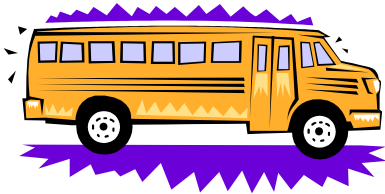
Regular attendance at school is important for children to achieve their full potential. The attendance pattern of each child is reviewed periodically. Parents will be promptly notified if there is a concern that the child's absence is threatening his/her academic success.

Students who are dropped off at school in the morning, and those who arrive after the 9:00 a.m. bell must be signed in by a parent/guardian/adult at the front office.



TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM SCHOOL

School bus service is a privilege and not a right. To that effect, students must respect the rules and regulations or face consequences which may include the removal of the transportation privilege. Students damaging or vandalizing a school bus may be suspended from transportation until arrangements have been made for the payment of the total cost of all damage.



STUDENT TRANSPORTATION OF EASTERN ONTARIO BUS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

The pupil must:

1. not smoke on the school bus
2. obey direction and/or instructions of the driver promptly
3. remain seated while the vehicle is in motion
4. refrain from unnecessarily loud or boisterous talking while en route
5. keep arms, head and feet inside the vehicle
6. do not throw anything from the windows of a vehicle

7. never interfere with an emergency door, exit or any other part of the vehicle's equipment unless in an emergency situation
8. not use profane language
9. not consume food or beverages while in the vehicle
10. refrain from any activity which may be injurious to themselves or other pupils or their belongings
11. not be picked up or discharged at a location other than at the usual station of contract without permission of the Student Transportation Eastern Ontario
12. not engage in any undesirable behaviour
13. be on time
14. keep the aisle free at all times of books, sports equipment, gym bags, etc.
15. keep the bus clean
16. sit in an assigned seat if such is deemed necessary by the Principal and bus contractor
